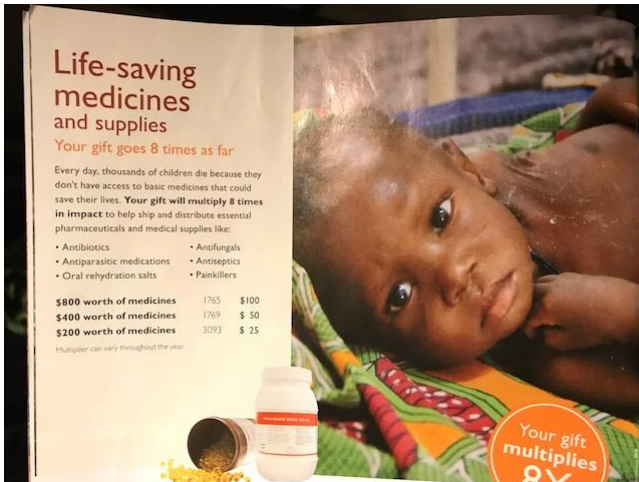

You’re invited to order one or more poinsettias in memory of, or in honor of loved ones. Mail or drop off the order form with your payment at the church office.

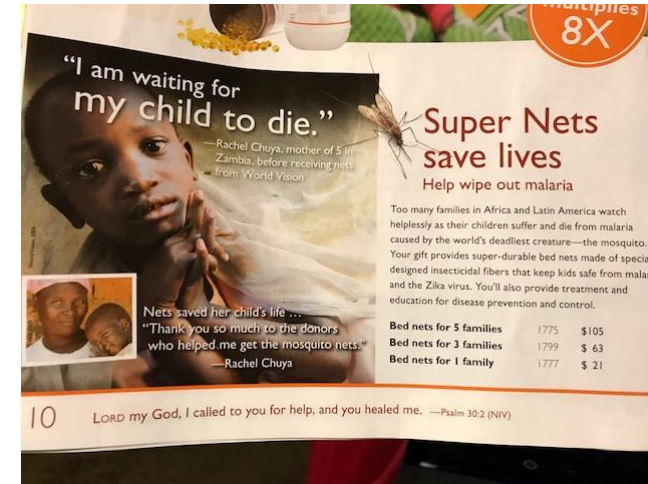

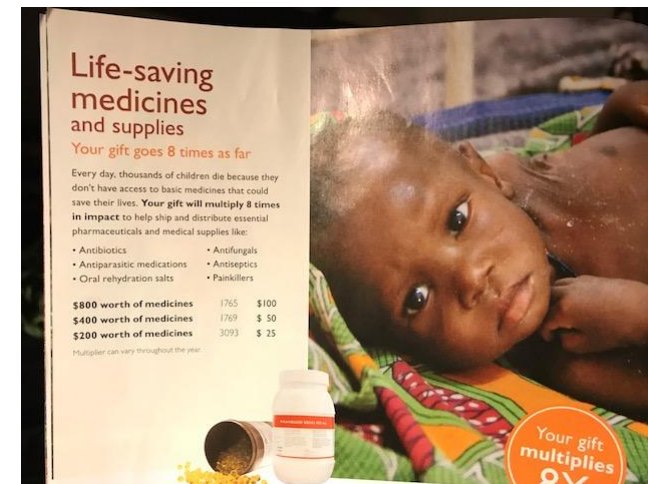
