**Donating Convalescent Plasma:** Plasma is the liquid portion of blood rich in antibodies used to treat or prevent infection. If you were confirmed to have COVID-19, your body may be producing specific COVID-19 antibodies. Convalescent plasma (CCP) can be provided to current COVID-19 patients as an experimental form of treatment. Please consider donating if you meet the criteria.
