L(7): The nations make much ado, and the kingdoms are shaken; God has spoken, and the earth shall melt away.

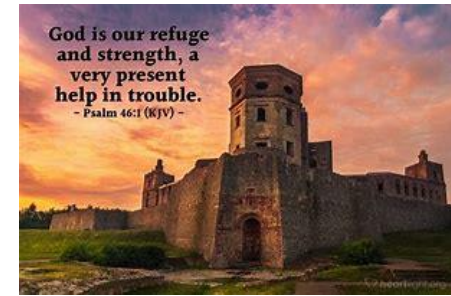
C(8): The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our stronghold.
